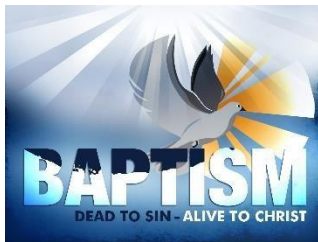
We seek to support our ministry through regular
